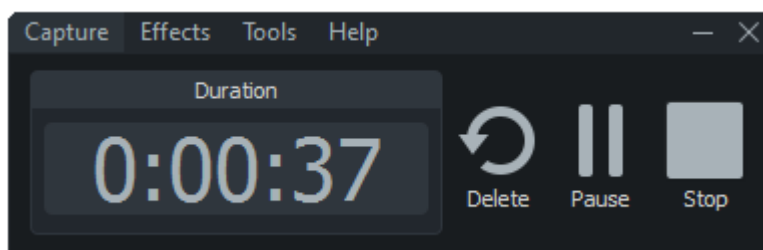
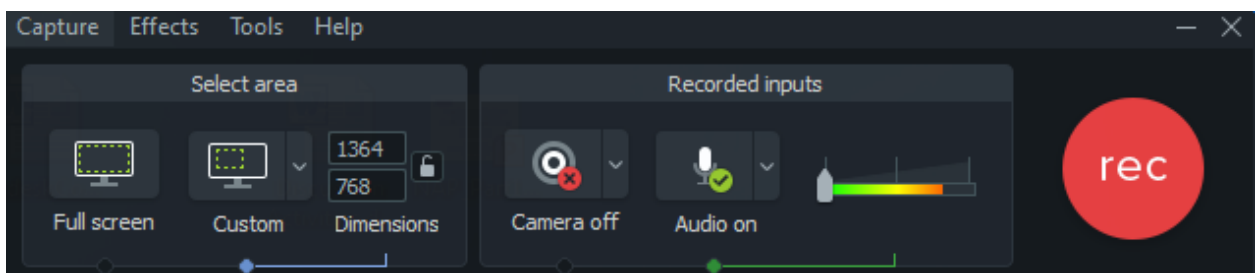
For example, this software will allow you to easily record a PowerPoint presentation with a voiceover or upload a previously created mp4. The film can be easily edited using the tools available including cutaways, transitions, zoom in or pan.

- 1 Choose your footage**
Create a great looking video, even if you've never made one before. Camtasia makes it easy to record your screen or import your own video and audio files (MP4, WMV, MOV, AVI, etc.).
- 2 Make your edits**
The multi-track timeline expands to fit all your projects. Split clips into two, remove portions of a clip, or delete one entirely. You can also add music, photos, narration, and more.
- 3 Create your video**
Anyone can make and share engaging videos with Camtasia. Upload your videos to Youtube, Vimeo, Facebook, or Screencast.com. Make videos from start to finish in hours, not days.

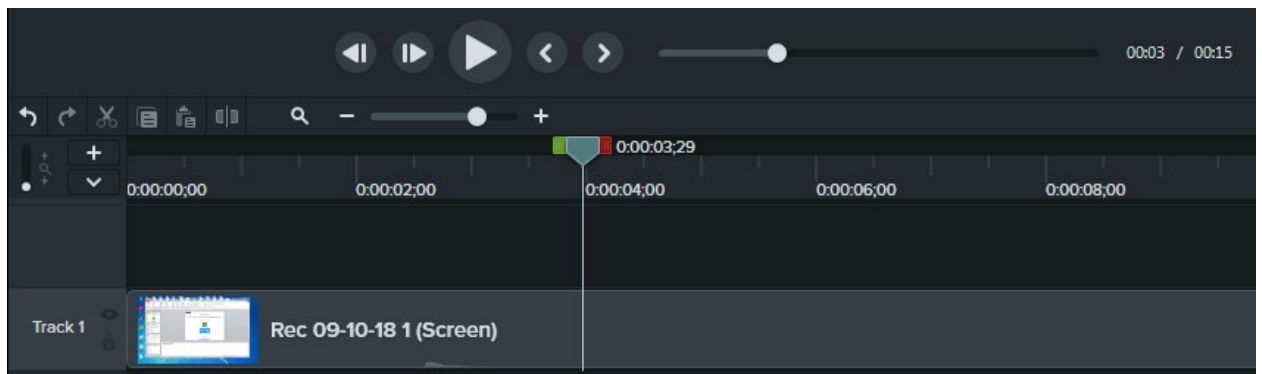
How to use Camtasia 9

Use the diagrams below and follow the numbers to navigate the interface

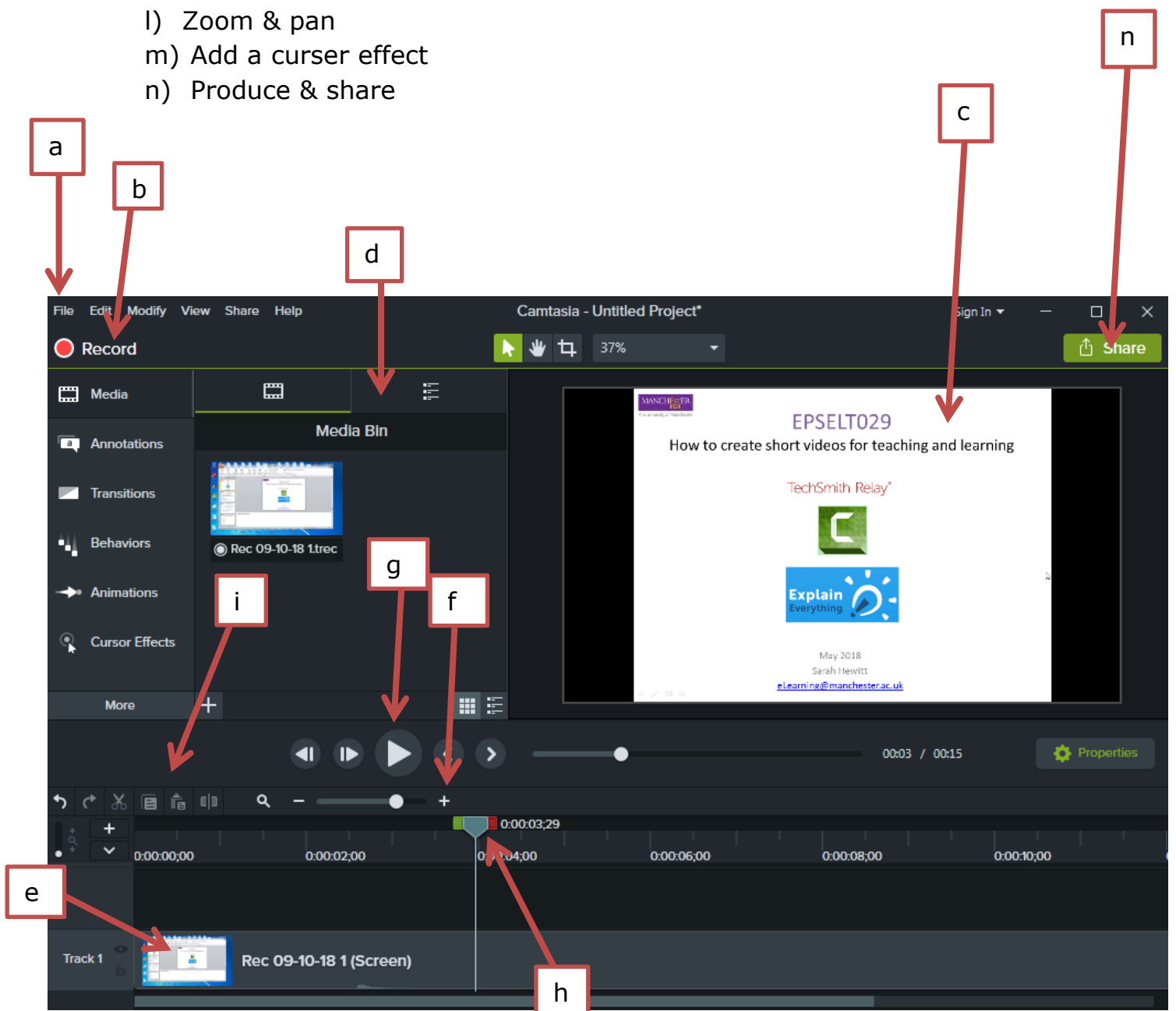
1. Open the software from the desktop 
 - a) Import media (.mp4) using the toolbar or
 - b) Record the screen as a new clip
 - c) Open up your Powerpoint presentation

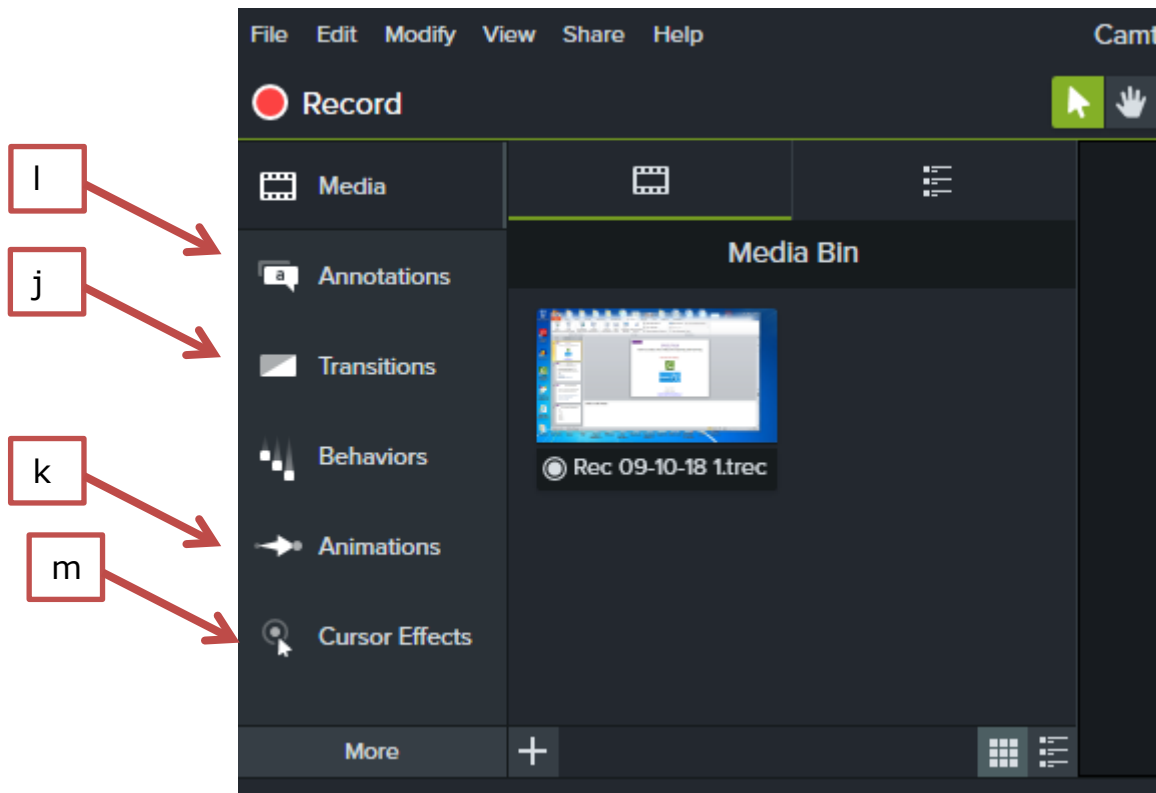


- d) All imported or recorded clips are stored in the media bin
- e) Drag the clip to the timeline



- f) Zoom the clip in and out for a better view
- g) Play the clip
- h) Move the playhead to edit the clip
- i) Cut or split the clip
- j) Add a transition
- k) Add a callout
- l) Zoom & pan
- m) Add a cursor effect
- n) Produce & share
