

## How to Access Your Reading List

Your online reading list is a list of recommended readings, with access to:

- real time information about books' availability,
- the Universities online reading resources,
- links to external web pages,
- digitised extracts of key readings as requested by academic staff.

Links to your reading lists are available **via module content on Blackboard**.

### Via your Blackboard Course

You can access the Reading List for a course from the course menu (or sometimes a link from within a content area).
