

## How to Find Your Feedback for Turnitin and Blackboard Assignments

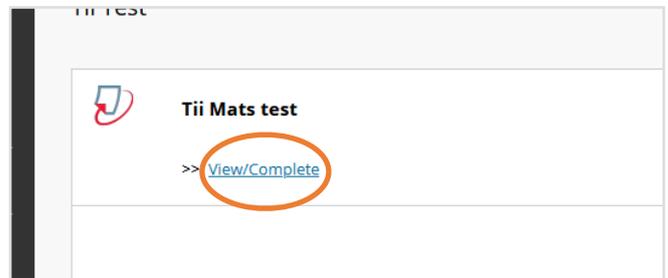
Online assignments can be submitted using Turnitin or the Blackboard Assignment tool. Your tutors use these tools to assign marks and leave feedback on your work. This factsheet details how you can retrieve this feedback from both these tools.

### Turnitin Feedback

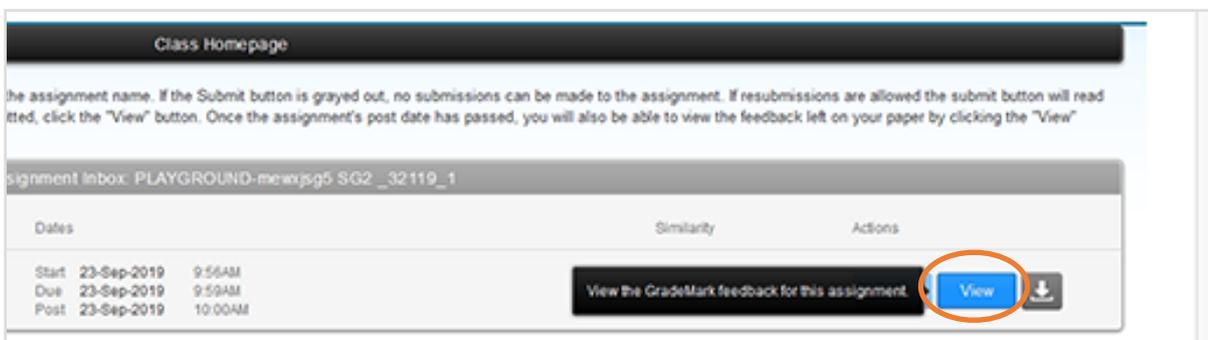
Feedback on Turnitin Assignments is accessible via Turnitin Feedback Studio. There are two ways to navigate to Turnitin Feedback Studio from Blackboard.

#### Method 1

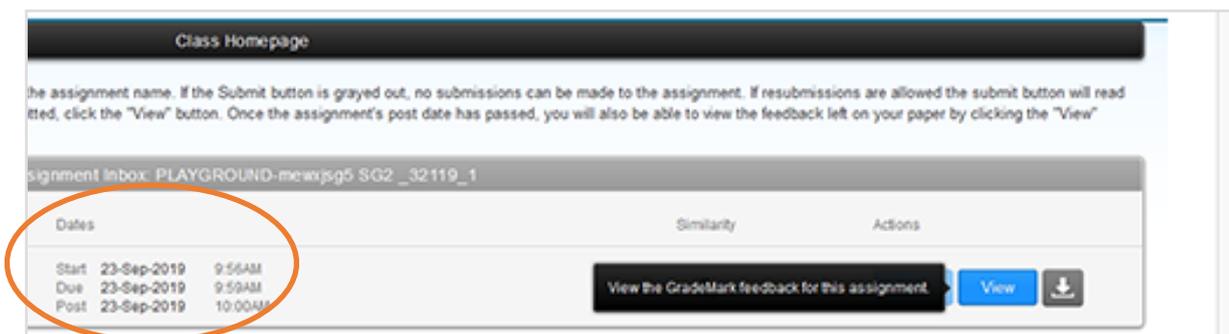
Log into your Blackboard Course Unit and navigate to the Turnitin Assignment Inbox where you submitted your assignment. Click the **View/Complete** link.



Then, click **View** to open Turnitin Feedback Studio:



Please note that grades and feedback are only available once the post-date for the assignment has been reached. You can see when this is in the **Dates** section:

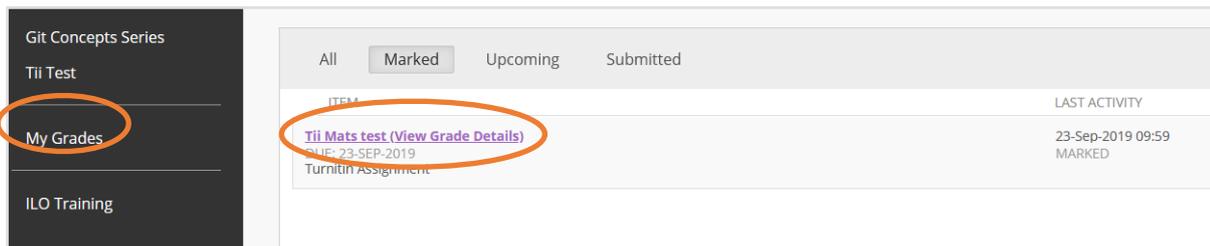

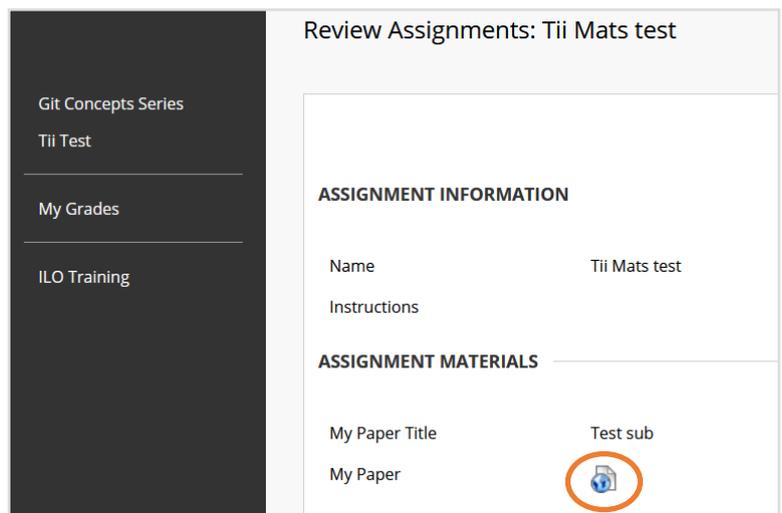
### Method 2

You can also access Turnitin Feedback Studio, by selecting **My Grades** on the sidebar menu (if this is enabled in your course unit).

After selecting **My Grades**, click on the **Marked** tab and then click on the title of the assignment you wish to view:

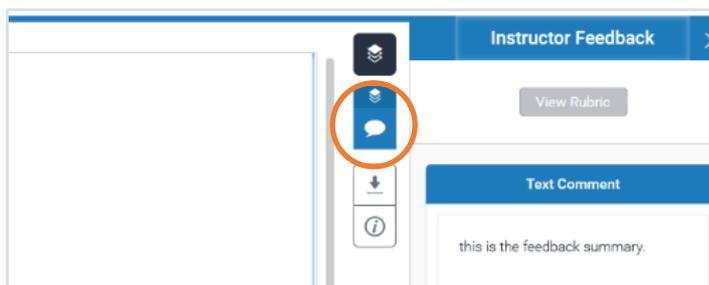


In the **Review Assignments** screen, select the My Paper icon:



### Turnitin Feedback Studio

In Turnitin Feedback Studio, feedback will be in the form of annotations (which you will see added to your submission), general feedback and/or a rubric. To view the rubric and general feedback, click on the speech bubble:



## Blackboard Feedback

There are two ways to access feedback for Blackboard Assignments.

### Method 1

Log into your Blackboard Course Unit and navigate to the Blackboard Assignment inbox (where you submitted your assignment). Click the assignment link.

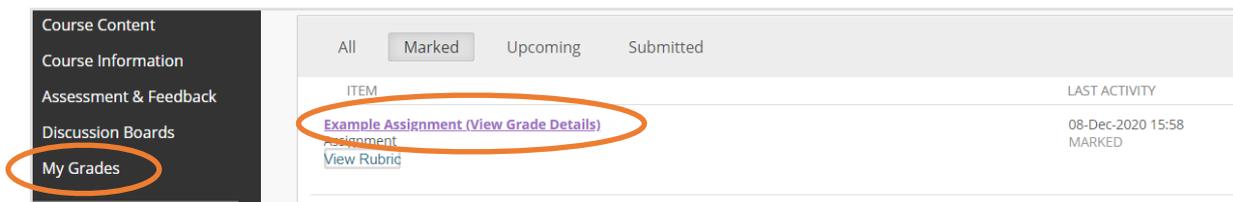


You will then see your submission with any marks and feedback added.

### Method 2

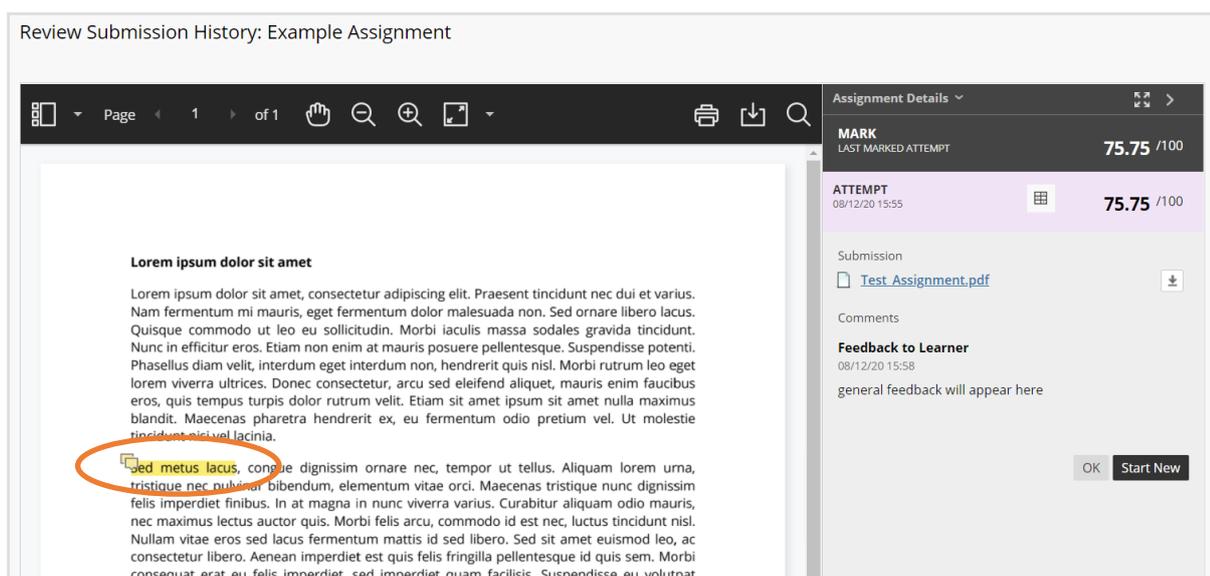
You can also access Blackboard assignment feedback, by selecting **My Grades** on the sidebar menu (if this is enabled in your course unit).

After selecting **My Grades**, click on the title of the assignment you wish to view:



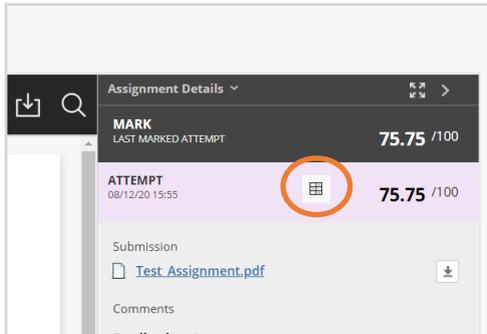
## Blackboard Assignment Feedback

Your feedback may be in the form of (1) annotations on your assignment,

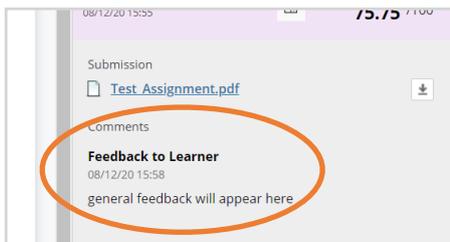


## Blackboard Feedback

(2) feedback within a marking rubric (to access this, click the rubric icon, if it is available) and/or



or (3) general feedback comments



You can click the **Download** icon to download your annotated assignment.
