Copying a Blackboard test from one Blackboard course to another (such as a previous year's course unit)

This guide explains step-by-step how to copy a Blackboard test from one Blackboard course to another. To do this, you must export the test from the original Blackboard course and then import it into the new Blackboard course.

Exporting a Test

- To export a Blackboard test, log into Blackboard and open the Blackboard course where the test is located.
- Under Course Management in the left navigation bar, open Course Tools.



• Then select Tests, Surveys & Pools.

- Open the **Tests** page and a list of all tests in the Blackboard course will appear.
- Find the test you would like to copy, click on the drop-down arrow next to the test name and select **Export to Local Computer** as shown below.

• Save the exported file to a location on your computer. You will need to find this file to import to the new Blackboard course.

Importing the Test

To import the test, open the new Blackboard course where you would like to add the test. Under **Course Management** in the left navigation bar, open **Course Tools**.
